1 pair 3¾mm (no 9) (US 5) needles

TENSION

22 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 3¾mm (US 5) needles.

These 170 rows form stripe sequence and are repeated as required.

BACK

Using 3¹/₄mm (US 3) needles and yarn A cast on 101 [113: 125: 139] sts. Beg with stripe row 1, work in stripe sequence throughout as follows:

Row 1 (RS): K1, *P1, K1, rep from * to end.

Row 2: P1, *K1, P1, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 6 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 3³/₄mm (US 5) needles.

Next row (RS): K2 [2: 2: 3], P1, *K5, P1, rep from * to last 2 [2: 2: 3] sts, K2 [2: 2: 3].

Next row: P2 [2: 2: 3], K1, *P5, K1, rep from * to last 2 [2: 2: 3] sts, P2 [2: 2: 3].

These 2 rows form patt.

Cont in patt, dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 10th row until 91 [103: 115: 129] sts rem.

Work 13 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 6th row until there are 101 [113: 125: 139] sts, taking inc sts into patt.

Cont straight until back meas 36 [37: 38: 39] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armholes

Keeping stripes and patt correct, cast off 4 [5: 6: 7] sts at beg of

next 2 rows.

93 [103: 113: 125] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 [5: 7: 9] rows, then on foll 3 [4: 3: 4] alt rows.

81 [85: 93: 99] sts.

Cont straight until armhole meas 21 [22: 23: 24] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulders and back neck

Cast off 4 [4: 4: 5] sts at beg of next 2 rows.

73 [77: 85: 89] sts.

Next row (RS): Cast off 4 [4: 5: 5] sts, patt until there are 22 [24: 26: 28] sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next row, 4 [4: 5: 5] sts at beg of foll row, 4 sts at beg of next row, 4 [4: 5: 6] sts at beg of next row, then 2 sts at beg of foll row, ending with RS facing for next row.

Cast off rem 3 [5: 5: 6] sts.

With RS facing, rejoin appropriate yarn to rem sts, cast off centre 21 [21: 23: 23] sts, patt to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

LEFT FRONT

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn A cast on 51 [57: 63: 71] sts.

Beg with stripe row 1, work in stripe sequence throughout as folls:

Work in rib as given for back for 8 rows, dec

0 [0: 0: 1] st at end of last row and ending with RS facing for next row. 51 [57: 63: 70] sts.

Change to 3¾mm (US 5) needles.

Next row (RS): K3 [3: 3: 4], *P1, K5, rep from * to end.

Next row: *P5, K1, rep from * to last 3 [3: 3: 4] sts, P3 [3: 3: 4].

These 2 rows form patt.

Cont in patt, dec 1 st at beg of next and every foll 10th row until 46 [52: 58: 65] sts rem.

Work 13 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Inc 1 st at beg of next and every foll 6th row until there are 51 [57: 63: 70] sts, taking inc sts into patt.

Cont straight until left front matches back to beg of armhole shaping, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape armhole

Keeping stripes and patt correct, cast off 4 [5: 6: 7] sts at beg of next row. 47 [52: 57: 63] sts.

Work 1 row.

Dec 1 st at armhole edge of next 3 [5: 7: 9] rows, then on foll 3 [4: 3: 4] alt rows.

41 [43: 47: 50] sts.

Cont straight until 33 [33: 35: 35] rows less have been worked than on back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with WS facing for next row.

Shape neck

Keeping stripes and patt correct, cast off 5 sts at beg of next row, then 3 sts at beg of foll alt row. 33 [35: 39: 42] sts.

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 6 rows, then on foll 7 [7: 8: 8] alt rows, then on foll 4th row.

19 [21: 24: 27] sts.

Work 6 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 4 [4: 4: 5] sts at beg of next and foll

3 [3: 0: 2] alt rows, then 0 [0: 5: 6] sts at beg of foll 0 [0: 3: 1] alt rows.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 3 [5: 5: 6] sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn A cast on 51 [57: 63: 71] sts.

Beg with stripe row 1, work in stripe sequence throughout as folls:

Work in rib as given for back for 8 rows, dec

0 [0: 0: 1] st at beg of last row and ending with RS facing for next row. 51 [57: 63: 70] sts.

Change to 3¾mm (US 5) needles.

Next row (RS): *K5, P1, rep from * to last

3 [3: 3: 4] sts, K3 [3: 3: 4].

Next row: P3 [3: 3: 4], *K1, P5, rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form patt.

Cont in patt, dec 1 st at end of next and every foll 10th row until 46 [52: 58: 65] sts rem.

Complete to match left front, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn A cast on 65 [67: 69: 69] sts.

Beg with stripe row 1, work in stripe sequence throughout as folls:

Work in rib as given for back for 8 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Change to 3¾mm (US 5) needles.

Next row (RS): K2 [3: 4: 4], P1, *K5, P1, rep from * to last 2 [3: 4: 4] sts, K2 [3: 4: 4].

Next row: P2 [3: 4: 4], K1, *P5, K1, rep from * to last 2 [3: 4: 4] sts, P2 [3: 4: 4].

These 2 rows form patt.

Cont in patt, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of 7th [7th: 7th: 5th] and every foll 10th [10th: 10th: 8th] row to 69 [81: 91: 89] sts,

then on every foll 12th [12th: -: 10th] row until there are 83 [87: -: 95] sts, taking inc sts into patt.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 45 [46: 47: 47] cm, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape top

Keeping stripes and patt correct, cast off 4 [5: 6: 7] sts at beg of next 2 rows. 75 [77: 79: 81] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 rows, then on every foll alt row to 47 sts, then on foll 9 rows, ending with RS facing for next row. 29 sts.

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 23 sts.

Making Up

Press.

Join both shoulder seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

Front bands (both alike)

With RS facing, using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn D, pick up and knit 101 [105: 109: 113] sts evenly along front opening edge, between neck shaping and cast-on edge.

**Beg with row 2, work in rib as given for back as folls:

Using yarn D, work 1 row.

Using yarn C, work 1 row.

Using yarn B, work 2 rows.

Using yarn A, work 3 rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

Using yarn A, cast off in rib.

Neckband and ties

Using 3¼mm (US 3) needles and yarn D, cast on 61 sts, with RS facing, pick up and knit

43 [43: 45: 45] sts up right side of neck, 37 [37: 39: 39] sts from back, and 43 [43: 45: 45] sts down left side of neck, then turn and cast on 61 sts. 245 [245: 251: 251] sts.

Work as given for front bands from **.

Set in sleeves using the set-in method.
