What You'll Need

YARN

TLC Essentials, 6oz/170g skeins, each approx 312yd/285m (acrylic)

- 3 skeins #2112 Black (A)
- 2 skeins #2615 Light Celery (B)
- 2 skeins #2313 Aran (C)
- 2 skeins #2220 Butter (D)
- 2 skeins #2919 Barn Red (E)
- 1 skein #2680 Eden Green (F)
- 1 skein #2531 Light Plum (G)
- 1 skein #2936 Claret (H)

CROCHET HOOK

- Size I/9 (5.50mm) crochet hook or any size to obtain correct gauge

NOTIONS

- Yarn needle

Skill Level: Intermediate



ABBREVIATIONS USED IN THIS PATTERN

ch(s) chain(s) **sl st** slip stitch
dc double crochet **sp(s)** space(s)
sc single crochet **st(s)** stitch(es)
sk skip

* Repeat directions following * as many times as indicated.

[] Work directions in brackets number of times indicated.

() Work directions in parentheses into stitch or space indicated.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

V-st (V-stitch) Work (dc, ch 3, dc) in specified stitch or space.

shell Work 5 dc in specified stitch or space.

Tip

Try varying the width of each stripe by changing colors every 3, 4 or 5 rows (or wherever you like) instead of every 2 rows throughout.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Approx 66"/167.5cm wide x 72"/183cm high

GAUGE

11 dc = 4"/10cm; 7 dc rows = 4¼"/11cm

Remember to check gauge for best results!

HOW TO MAKE A GAUGE SWATCH

Ch 13.

Row 1 Dc in 4th ch from hook (skipped chs count as dc), dc in each rem ch across—11 dc.

Rows 2–7 Ch 3 (counts as dc now and throughout), turn; dc in next dc and in each dc across. Swatch should measure approx 4"/10cm wide x 4¼"/11cm high.

If necessary, adjust hook size to obtain correct gauge.

COVERLET

With A, ch 223 loosely.

Row 1 (right side) Dc in 4th ch from hook (skipped chs count as dc), dc in next 10 chs, *V-st in next ch, dc in next 12 chs**, sk next 3 chs, dc in next 12 chs; repeat from * across, ending last repeat at **—8 ch-3 sps and 208 dc.

Row 2 Turn; sk first dc, sl st in next dc, ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), dc in next 11 dc, *V-st in ch-3 sp of next V-st, dc in next 12 dc**, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 12 dc; repeat from * across, ending last repeat at **. Fasten off, leaving last dc unworked.

Row 3 With right side facing, sk first dc, join B with sl st in next dc, ch 3, dc in next 11 dc, *V-st in ch-3 sp of next V-st, dc in next 12 dc**, sk next 2 dc, dc in next 12 dc; repeat from * across, ending last repeat at **.

Row 4 Repeat Row 2.

Rows 5–20 Repeat Rows 3 and 4, 8 more times, changing color at beginning of each odd-numbered row and working 2 rows of

the yarn

each color in the following sequence: C, D, E, A, F, G, H, A, B.

Rows 21–92 Repeat Rows 3–20, four more times.

Rows 93–102 Repeat Rows 3–12. At end of last row, fasten off.

BORDER

Right Edge

Row 1 With right side facing, join A with sl st in bottom right-hand corner ch (3rd skipped ch at beginning of Row 1 of coverlet); working across right edge, ch 1, sc in same ch as joining, *2 sc in edge of each row, sc in top of dc or in 3rd ch of ch-3 on each row; repeat from * across—307 sc.

Row 2 Ch 1, turn; sc in first sc, *ch 2, sk next 2 sc, sc in next sc; repeat from * across—102 ch-2 sps.

Row 3 Ch 1, turn; sc in first sc, *shell in next ch-2 sp, sc in next ch-2 sp; repeat from * across; sc in last sc—51 shells. Fasten off.

Left Edge

Row 1 With right side facing, join A with sl st in 3rd ch of beginning ch-3 on Row 102 in top left-hand corner; working across left edge, ch 1, sc in same ch as joining, *2 sc in edge of each row, sc in top of dc or in 3rd ch of ch-3 on each row; repeat from * across, sc in foundation ch at base of last dc on Row 1 of coverlet—307 sc.

Row 2 Work same as Row 2 on right edge border.

Row 3 Ch 1, turn; sc in first sc, *sc in next ch-2 sp, shell in next ch-2 sp; repeat from * across, sc in last sc—51 shells. Do not fasten off.

Bottom Edge

Row 1 Ch 2, sl st in edge of last sc on Row 1 of left edge border; working in free loops of foundation chs across bottom edge, *[ch 2, sk next ch, sl st in next ch] 6 times, sk next ch, sl st in next ch, [ch 2, sk next ch, sl st in next ch] 5 times**, ch 2, sk next ch, (sl st, ch 3, sl st) in ch-3 sp; repeat from * across, ending

last repeat at **, ch 2, sk last ch, sl st in edge of first sc on Row 1 of right edge border, ch 2; join with sl st in first sc on Row 3 of right edge border. Fasten off.

Top Edge

Row 1 With right side facing, join A with sl st in edge of last sc on Row 3 of right edge border; working across top edge, ch 2, sl st in edge of last sc on Row 1 of right edge border, [ch 2, sk next dc, sl st in next dc] 6 times, *ch 2, sk next dc, (sl st, ch 3, sl st) in ch-3 sp, [ch 2, sk next dc, sl st in next dc] 6 times**, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, sl st in next dc, [ch 2, sk next dc, sl st in next dc] 5 times; repeat from * across, ending last repeat at **, ch 2, sk last dc, sl st in edge of first sc on Row 1 of left edge border, ch 2; join with sl st in first sc on Row 3 of left edge border. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends. Block as needed.
