

## Maze Bag & Scarf

Patons 100% 4ply

### Materials

Patons 100% Cotton 4ply, 3 x 50g balls (01692)

Prym 2.50 mm crochet hook

Scarf: Approx 550 beads (ref J3001005 and J3001015)

Bag: Approx 900 beads (ref J3001005 and J3001015)

Piece of lining fabric measuring 32 cm x 15 cm

### Size

#### Scarf:

Actual size

14	x	150	cm
5 1/2	x	59	in

#### Bag:

Actual size

14	x	12	cm
5 1/2	x	4 1/2	in

### Tension

27 sts and 13 rows to 10 cm (pattern) on 2.50 mm hook or size needed to achieve stated tension.

### Special Abbreviations

Bead 1 = slide a bead up next to hook and make 1 ch to secure bead in place on work.

### BEADING NOTE

Before starting to crochet, thread beads onto yarn. To do this, thread a fine sewing needle (one that will easily pass through the beads) with sewing thread. Knot ends of thread and then pass end of yarn through this loop. Thread a bead onto sewing thread and then gently slide it along and onto yarn. Continue in this way until required number of beads are on yarn. Two types of bead have been used – mix beads together and then thread onto yarn so that bead colours are random.

### Instructions

#### SCARF

With 2.50 mm hook, make foundation ch thus: 1 ch, (bead 1,



1 ch) 19 times, 2 ch, bead 1 (42 ch including beaded ch).

Foundation row - (WS), 1 tr into 6th st from hook, \*bead 1, miss 1 st, 1 tr into next ch; rep from \* to end, turn (39 sts).

Patt thus:

Row 1 - 3 ch (counts as first tr), \*bead 1, miss 1 st, 1 tr into next tr; rep from \* to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of previous row, turn.

This row forms beaded mesh patt.

Work in beaded mesh patt for a further 11 rows.

Next row - 4 ch (counts as first tr and 1 ch), miss first 2 sts, \*1 tr into next tr, 1 ch, miss 1 st; rep from \* to last st, 1 tr into top of 3 ch at beg of previous row, turn.

Next row - 4 ch (counts as first tr and 1 ch), miss first 2 sts, \*1 tr into next tr, 1 ch, miss 1 ch; rep from \* to last st, 1 tr into 3rd of 4 ch at beg of previous row, turn.

Rep last row until Scarf meas 139 cm.

Next row - 4 ch (counts as first tr and

1 ch), miss first 2 sts, \*1 tr into next tr, bead 1, miss 1 ch; rep from \* to last st, 1 tr into 3rd of 4 ch at beg of previous row, turn.

Work a further 13 rows in beaded mesh patt.

Fasten off.

## MAKE UP

Press carefully following instructions on ball band.

## BAG

### SIDES (Make 2)

With 2.50 mm hook, make foundation ch thus: 1 ch, (bead 1, 1 ch) 19 times, 2 ch, bead 1 (42 ch including beaded ch).

Foundation row - (WS), 1 tr into 6th st from hook, \*bead 1, miss 1 st, 1 tr into next ch; rep from \* to end, turn (39 sts).

Patt thus:

Row 1 - 3 ch (counts as first tr), \*bead 1, miss 1 st, 1 tr into next tr; rep from \* to end, working last tr into top of 3 ch at beg of previous row, turn.

This row forms patt.

Cont in patt for a further 14 rows.

Fasten off.

## STRAP

With 2.50 mm hook, make foundation ch thus: (1 ch, bead 1) 107 times, 2 ch (216 ch including beaded ch).

Row 1 - (WS), 1 dc into 2nd ch from hook, \*1 ch, miss 1 st, 1 dc into next ch; rep from \* to end, turn (215 sts).

Row 2 - 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into first dc, \*1 dc into next ch sp, 1 dc into next dc; rep from \* to end, turn.

Row 3 - 1 ch (does NOT count as st), 1 dc into first dc, \*bead 1, miss 1 dc, 1 dc into next dc; rep from \* to end.

Fasten off.

## MAKE UP

Press carefully following instructions on ball band.

From lining fabric, cut two pieces same size as Sides, adding seam allowance along all edges.

Join Sides along 3 edges, leaving foundation ch edge open. Attach ends of Strap to inside of upper edges over seams.

Join lining sections along 3 sides. Fold seam allowance to inside around opening edge. Slip lining inside Bag and sew folded edge in place around upper edge.
