Georgie's Corsage

Instructions

Take 3 complimenting fabrics, you need approx 20cms of each double. (We have used Rowan's Kaffe Fassett and Amy Butler fabric for ours)

Take 2 plates, one 20cms approx in diameter and the other 15cms.

Cut round one of the 20cms with the fabric double and wrong sides together (this is for the outer petals), cut round the other plate twice for the next two layers. you should now have 3 circles of fabric all double.

Take the circles of fabric (Keeping them double) and fold them into quarters and then half again.

Cut a heart shape at the edge of the quarter, this will give you a petal shape. (You may like to experiment with a piece of paper first!) Repeat this for the other two circles.

Now zig zag round the edges of each circle to join the two pieces together.

Decide which one of the smaller circles you wish to have as your centre and put to one side.

The remaining two circles, fold into quarters and then half again and snip off the point. (this is to make a small hole in the centre of the circle.)

Take the centre circle and gather it up in your hand to form a flower, hand stitch the folds into place.

Take the remaining small circle (With hole) and slide it onto the centre and gather it around the stem and stitch into place.

Repeat with the larger circle.

You may want to play with the gathers to make it flower like and stitch where needed.

Add a corsage pin and wear with pride as you have created this yourself!!
