

# Mans Texture Sweater with Collar



## PATONS YARN REQUIRED - IMPORTANT!

Use only the yarn specified for these garments. Other yarns may give unsatisfactory results. Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Be sure to check the ball bands to ensure all yarn is from the same dye lot.

## NEEDLES AND EXTRAS

- 1 pair each 4.50mm (UK 7) (US 7) and 4.00mm (UK 8) (US 6) Knitting Needles or sizes needed to give correct tension.
- 2 Coats Buttons (#0205).
- A Wool Needle for sewing in ends.

## TENSION

With Correct Yarn and Tension, your garment will look like our photograph.  
17 sts and 29 rows to 10 cm over patt, using 4.50mm Needles.

To work a 15 cm x 15 cm tension square, use 4.50mm Needles, cast on 25 sts. Work 44 rows patt as for Back. Cast off loosely. Please check your tension carefully. If less sts use smaller needles, if more sts use bigger needles.

### SPECIAL ABBREVIATION

M1 – Make 1 – Pick up loop which lies before next stitch, place on left hand needle and knit (or purl) into back of loop.

## MANS TEXTURE SWEATER WITH COLLAR

### BACK

Note - This instruction has been written specifically for the stitch pattern given. Using any other stitch may result in a garment that is the wrong shape or size.

Using 4.50mm Needles, cast on 81 (89-97-113-121-129) sts.

Beg patt - 1st row (wrong side) - \* P1, K7, rep from \* to last st, P1.

2nd and foll alt rows - Knit.

3rd row - P2, K5, \* P3, K5, rep from \* to last 2 sts, P2.

5th row - P3, K3, \* P5, K3, rep from \* to last 3 sts, P3.

7th row - P4, K1, \* P7, K1, rep from \* to last 4 sts, P4.

9th row - K4, P1, \* K7, P1, rep from \* to last 4 sts, K4.

11th row - K3, P3, \* K5, P3, rep from \* to last 3 sts, K3.

13th row - K2, P5, \* K3, P5, rep from \* to last 2 sts, K2.

15th row - K1, \* P7, K1, rep from \* to end.

16th row - As 2nd row.

Rows 1 to 16 incl form patt.

Cont in patt until work measures approx 46 cm, ending with a 7th or 15th patt row.

### SHAPE ARMHOLES -

Keeping patt correct, cast off 3 (5-6-9-10-11) sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 75 (79-85-95-101-107) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row until 69 (71-75-79-81-85) sts rem.

Work 9 (9-9-3-1-1) row/s patt. \*\*

Cont in patt without shaping until armhole measures 23 (24-25-26-27-28) cm, working last row on wrong side.

### SHAPE SHOULDERS -

Cast off 7 (7-8-8-8-8) sts at beg of next 4 rows, then 8 (8-7-8-8-9) sts at beg of foll 2 rows.

Cast off rem 25 (27-29-31-33-35) sts.

### front

Work as for Back to \*\*.

### DIVIDE FOR NECK OPENING -

Next row - Patt 32 (33-35-37-38-40), cast off next 5 sts loosely, patt to end.

Cont on last 32 (33-35-37-38-40) sts and work 25 rows patt.

Next row (right side) - Cast off 5 (5-6-6-7-7) sts, patt to end ... 27 (28-29-31-31-33) sts.

Dec one st at neck edge in every foll alt row until 24 (24-25-27-27-28) sts rem, then in every foll 4th row until 22 (22-23-24-24-25) sts rem.

Cont in patt without shaping until armhole measures same as Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with same patt row.

Work 1 row patt.

### SHAPE SHOULDER -

Cast off 7 (7-8-8-8) sts at beg of next row and foll alt row. Work 1 row. Cast off rem 8 (8-7-8-8-9) sts.

With wrong side facing, join yarn to rem 32 (33-35-37-38-40) sts and work 26 rows patt.

Next row (wrong side) - Cast off 5 (5-6-6-7-7) sts, patt to end ... 27 (28-29-31-31-33) sts.

Dec one st at neck edge in next row, then in every foll alt row until 24 (24-25-27-27-28) sts rem, then in every foll 4th row until 22 (22-23-24-24-25) sts rem.

Cont in patt without shaping until armhole measures same as Back to beg of shoulder shaping, ending with same patt row.

#### SHAPE SHOULDER -

Complete as for other shoulder.

#### Sleeves

Using 4.50mm Needles, cast on 41 (41-49-49-49-49) sts.

Beg patt - Work 16 rows patt as for Back.

Cont in patt and working extra sts into patt, inc one st at each end of next row, then in every foll - 6th (6th-6th-6th-4th-4th) row until there are 47 (55-55-71-57-75) sts, then in every foll - 8th (8th-8th-8th-6th-6th) row until there are 71 (73-79-83-89-95) sts.

Cont in patt without shaping until work measures approx 48 cm from beg, ending with a 7th or 15th patt row.

#### SHAPE TOP -

Keeping patt correct, cast off 2 (3-3-5-5-6) sts at beg of next 2 rows ... 67 (67-73-73-79-83) sts.

Dec one st at each end of next row, then in every foll alt row until 25 (21-27-19-27-31) sts rem, then in every row until 11 (11-13-13-13-13) sts rem. Cast off.

#### collar

Using wool needle and mattress st seam, join shoulder seams.

Using 4.00mm Needles, cast on 85 (93-101-109-117-125) sts.

Knit in garter st (1st row is wrong side) until work measures 12 cm, working last row on wrong side.

Next row - K5, \* sl 1, K2tog, pssso, K5 rep from \* to end ... 65 (71-77-83-89-95) sts.

Next row - Knit.

Cast off 6 (7-8-8-9-10) sts at beg of next 6 rows.

Cast off rem 29 (29-29-35-35-35) sts loosely knitways.

#### PLACKETS

Using 4.00mm Needles, cast on 6 sts.

Knit 14 rows garter st.

15th row - K2, yfwd, K2tog, K2 ... buttonhole.

Knit 13 rows garter st.

29th row - As 15th row ... 2 buttonholes in all.

Knit 3 rows garter st.

Cast off knitways, thus completing left front placket.

Make another placket, omitting buttonholes.

#### make up

DO NOT PRESS. Using wool needle and mattress st seam, join side and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Sew plackets in position, placing cast on edges to sts cast off at centre front, lapping left front placket over right front placket and working through both thicknesses at centre front. Sew shaped edge of collar in position, beg and ending at centre of plackets and easing collar to fit. Sew on buttons. Sew in all ends.
