

Park Slope Quilt

From the Park Slope fabric collection by Erin McMorris for FreeSpirit. Quilt by Mimi

Materials Required

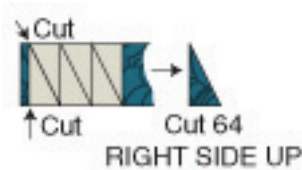
- EM01 Floral Swirl Teal 5/8 yard
- EM01 Floral Swirl Lime 5/8 yard
- EM02 Poppy Dot Floral Navy (1-way design) 1 1/2 yards
- EM02 Poppy Dot Floral Orange Fat qtr.
- EM03 Flower Field Turquoise Fat qtr.
- EM05 Circles and Stems Turquoise Fat qtr.
- EM07 Pebbles Teal 5/8 yard
- EM08 Leaf Dots Teal 1 yard
- Backing 3 yards
- Template Plastic
- Tri Recs by EZ Quilting, optional (All Tri and Recs pieces are cut from 4" x 2" strips.)



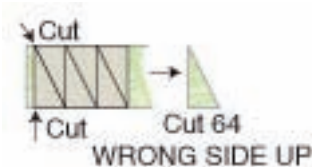
Cutting and Piecing Directions

1. Trace Triangle A-W, Triangle A-R, Triangle B, and centre square to template plastic. Templates include seam allowance. The centre square is marked for vertical and horizontal centre for fabrics with a one way design. Mark top of Triangle B.

2. Place Triangle A-R on fabric EM01 Teal and cut 2 strips the height of the triangle x WOF. Open strip so that you are cutting only 1 layer of fabric. Cut 64 Triangles A-R with fabric RIGHT SIDE UP. You can layer the 2 strips but both must be right side up. Rotate template and align edge with previous cut.



3. Place Triangle A-W on fabric EM01 Lime and cut 2 strips the height of the triangle x WOF. Open strip so that you are cutting only 1 layer of fabric. Cut 64 Triangles A-W with fabric WRONG SIDE UP. You can layer the 2 strips but both must be wrong side up. Rotate template and align edge with previous cut.

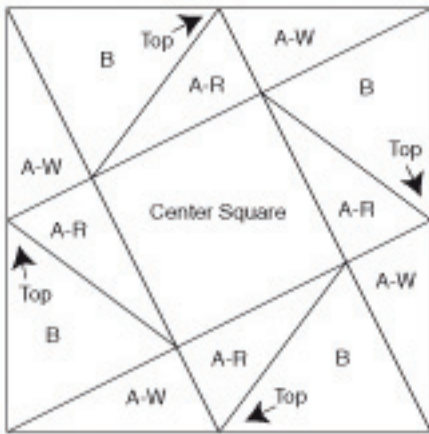


4. From each fat quarter EM02 Orange, EM03 Turquoise, and EM05 Turquoise, cut centre squares. For fabrics that are one way designs, align vertical line of square with vertical line of design. Cut 8 orange, and 4 of each turquoise for a total of 16 squares.

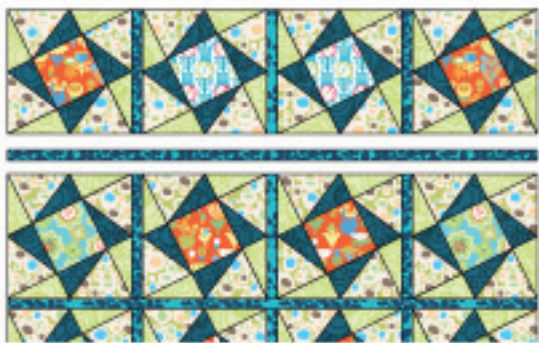
5. Place Triangle B on EM07 Teal and cut 4 strips the height of the triangle x WOF. Place triangle on strip and cut. Rotate template and align edge with previous cut. Cut 64 triangles.



6. Piece blocks following the diagram below. Make sure that the top of the B triangles are in the correct position. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. After stitching triangle pieces into rows, stitch the rows together to complete the block. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. Make 16 blocks.



7. From EM08 Teal, cut 6 strips $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF. Cut 12 rectangles $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " from strips. Arrange blocks in rows and stitch strips between blocks as shown. Make 4 rows. Trim the remaining 3 strips to $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $38\frac{3}{4}$ ". Stitch between rows.



8. From EM08 Teal, cut 4 strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Trim 2 strips to $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $38\frac{3}{4}$ ". Stitch to the sides of the quilt. Trim remaining strips to $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{3}{4}$ ". Stitch to the top and bottom of the quilt.

9. From EM08 Teal, cut 4 squares $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".

10. From EM02 Navy, Cut 2 strips $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Trim to $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{3}{4}$ ". Stitch to the top and bottom of the quilt. Cut 2 strips $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x LENGTH OF FABRIC. Trim to $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{3}{4}$ ". Stitch $5\frac{1}{2}$ " EM08 Teal squares to each end, then stitch strips to sides of quilt.



11. Layer, quilt, and bind. From EM02 Teal cut 5-6 binding strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Stitch together to make one continuous strip of binding.

Tip: Measure $\frac{1}{4}$ " from seam line and cut off tip of templates. You will be able to align the flat edge of top and the flat edge of the bottom with the cut edges of the fabric strip.
