

## Shawl cape

**Size** Width about 54 cm, length about 122 cm without tassels.

### Materials

Gedifra Cashmere (100% cashmere, about 112 m/25 g), 250 g #9669 beige.  
3-4 mm [size 3-6] needles, and one crochet hook to knot in the tassels, and 5 mother-of-pearl buttons

**Rib pattern:** on RS rows work alt K7, P2; on WS rows work sts. as they appear.

**Stockinet stitch (st-st):** K RS, P WS rows.

### Gauge:

26–27 sts. and 38 rows, each to 10 cm [4"].

### METHOD

Cast on 150 sts. and work 1st WS row as foll: edge st., \*P7, K2, rep from \*, end with P13, edge st. On foll 4 cm work sts. as they appear, then cont in st-st.

At the same time, when work measures 3 cm work 1st double buttonhole at right edge as foll: work edge st., then bind off 2, 5 in patt, bind off 2, work rem sts. in patt.

On foll row cast on 2 over those bound off. Work rem 4 double buttonholes alike, each 6 cm apart.

When work measures 46 cm bind off 6 sts. at right edge for underlap = 144 sts. When work measures 55 cm cont over all sts. in rib patt, starting after edge st. with K7, and ending in reverse. When work measures 67 cm cont again over all sts. in st-st.

When work measures 76 cm cast on 6 sts. anew at right edge for underlap = 150 sts. When work measures 118 cm work edge st. and 13 sts. st-st, then cont in rib patt, starting with P2 and ending with K7, edge st. When work measures 122 cm bind off all sts. Finishing: block piece to measurements, cover with a damp cloth and allow to dry. Turn underlaps in and sew in position, oversew the buttonholes with a thin thread (sewing thread) and sew buttons in position. Knot 17 groups of tassels to each foundation and bound-off edges of scarf, 1 group to each



outer edge, and rem between each 2 P sts. For each tassel cut threads about 16 cm long. Fold 4 threads in half, bring loop through the scarf with the crochet hook, then bring the loose ends through the loop.
