

Felted Jumper

Rowan

Materials

Rummage through your grannies wardrobe and try to find that old Aran jumper she had knitted once long ago!

For this project you will need a sweater that is at least a few sizes too big for you and made up of at least 70 – 100% wool.

Put it in the washing machine at 60 degrees (pop an old pair of jeans in with it too to agitate it).

EDGING DECORATION - MAKE 2

YARN

Cotton Glace

NEEDLES

4.5mm crochet hook.

Crocheted edging: Ch required length, to fit around hem / armhole borders and neck

Miss 1 ch, 1dc in each ch to end.

Turn, 1 ch, *Miss 1st dc, [dtr] 5 times into next dc, 1dc into each of next 3 dc; rep from * to end. Fasten off.

Sew in place

Making Up

Cut off sleeves and hem rib of jumper.

Use these pieces to make a halter neckband and 2 shorter pieces to make flowers, embroider around the edges with over stitch and contrast yarn, stitch into position

Using the hem rib of the jumper, cut a stripe of felted fabric and cut holes in garment to thread through the strip to create a belt.
