

Tuck Scarf

Size

From 43rd row scarf is about 9cm wide, length about 84cm (without pompoms). All measurements are in centimeters (cm). For approximate inch sizes simply multiply by 0.4 (or divide by 2.54).

Materials

Patons Pompero, 100g #00049 plum.
5-6mm [US 8-10] needles, or size to obtain gauge.

Basic pattern

See chart. Only RS rows are given, on WS rows work sts as they appear, purl yarn-overs.

Work rows 1-42 once, rows 43-66 four times, then rows 139-173.

Gauge

16-17 sts and 21-22 rows, each to 10cm [4"].

METHOD

Cast on 15 sts and work in basic patt foll chart.

When work measures about 80cm, after the 173 rows, pull rem 3 sts tog firmly with the working yarn.

Make 3 pompoms each about 4cm across; sew 2 pompoms to either side of the cast-on row, and 1 pompom to the tip.



Legend

- ▣ = 1 selvage st
- = K1 □ = P1
- ⊖ = 1 yarn-over
- ▣ = K2 together
- ▣ = slip 1 knitwise, K1, pass slipped st over
- ▣ = slip 2 tog knitwise, K1, pass slipped sts over
- ⊗ = make 1 purlwise tbl
- = bind off for the slit and cast on anew on next row
- ▣ = slip 3 onto a CN and leave at back of work, K2, then work P1 and K2 from CN
- ▣ = slip 2 onto a CN and leave at front of work, P1, then K2 from CN
- ▣ = slip 1 onto a CN and leave at back of work, K2, then P1 from CN
