

Santa and Angel

Size, approx. 10 cm (4 inches)

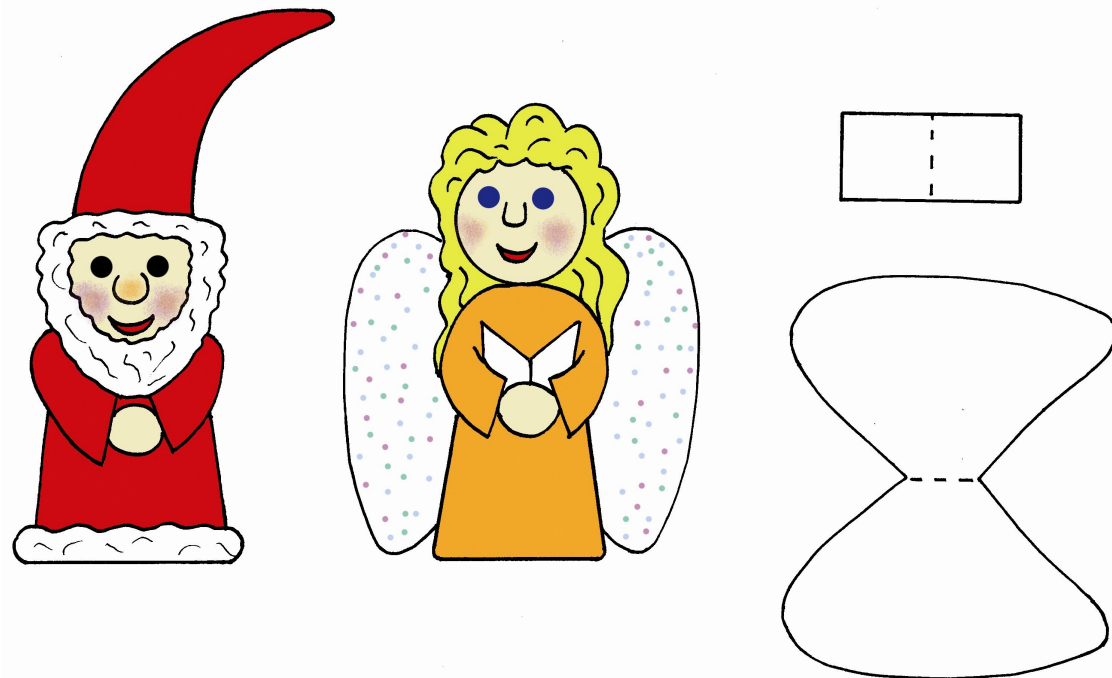
Materials For Angel:

Filz-it! Wool for needle felting:
 11 g in colour 0009 (pumpkin),
 1 g colour 0008 (gold),
 4.5 g colour 0018 (light brown), and small amounts of
 colours 0010 (red),
 0005 (orchid),
 0004 (royal blue),
 0002 (ecru);
 felt sheets: 1 piece, 10 cm x 10 cm (4 x 4 inches), of
 White Glitter and 1 piece, 4 cm x 2 cm (1 5/8 x 3/4
 inches), of White;
 1 Felting Needle Holder with 4 needles;
 1 felting needle with handle; 1 felting pad (from Coats)

For the sizes and shapes of the individual pieces, see the pattern diagram. Work larger pieces with the 4-needle felting needle, then smooth their surfaces with the 1-needle felting needle. Use the 1-needle felting needle to make small pieces and to work details, such as faces, etc..

With approx. 10 g of the pumpkin-coloured wool, form a cylinder to serve as the body. Now work on the felting pad with the 4-needle felting needle to felt the body form to a compact, sturdy shape. To do this, insert the needles evenly around the entire body form. Separate the remaining pumpkin-coloured wool (approx. 1 g) into 2 equal pieces. Roll each piece between the palms of your hands to form small arm shapes. Needle-felt the arms and then needle-felt them onto the body. For the head, roll approx. 4 g of the light brown wool into a ball and needle-felt it thoroughly. Then carefully needle-felt the head onto the body with well-placed jabs. With a small piece of the remaining light brown wool, roll a small ball for the nose. Lay this ball on the face and needle-felt it to form the nose. For the cheeks, mix small amounts of orchid and red wool, lay the cheeks in place, and needle-felt them in place. Now felt the mouth with red wool and the eyes with royal blue wool. With the remaining light brown wool, roll and felt a slightly larger ball for the hands, then needle-felt this hand piece onto the arms and the body. Use golden wool for the hair and felt it loosely onto the head. Cut the wings from the sheet of white glitter felt, following illus. A. Needle-felt the wings to the back of the angel. Then cut the song book from the sheet of white felt and needle-felt it to the hands and the body of the angel.





Santa

Size, approx. 12 cm (4 3/4 inches)

Materials For Santa :

Filz-it! Wool for needle felting: approx. 18 g of colour 0010 (red), 2 g of colour 0002 (ecru), 1 g of colour 0018 (light brown), and small amounts of colours 0009 (pumpkin), 0005 (orchid), and 0013 (black); 1 Felting Needle Holder with 4 needles;
1 felting needle with handle;
1 felting pad

For the sizes and shapes of the individual pieces, see the pattern diagram. Work larger pieces with the 4-needle felting needle, then smooth their surfaces with the 1-needle felting needle. Use the 1-needle felting needle to make small pieces and to work details, such as faces, etc..

With approx. 17 g of the red wool, form a cylinder to serve as the body and the cap. Now work on the felting pad with the 4-needle felting needle to felt the body form to a compact, sturdy shape, forming the upper end in the shape of the pointed, "hanging" cap. To do this, insert the needles evenly around the entire body form. Set aside tiny pieces of the red wool for the mouth and cheeks. Separate the remaining red wool (approx. 1 g) into 2 equal pieces. Roll each piece between the palms of your hands to form small arm shapes. Needle-felt the arms and then needle-felt them onto the body. For the face, lay half of the light brown wool on the body and felt it in place with 1 needle. Mix a small amount of the remaining light brown wool with a small amount of pumpkin-coloured wool and roll it into a small ball for the nose. Lay this ball on the face and needle-felt it to form the nose. With the remaining light brown wool, roll and felt a slightly larger ball for the hands. Lay this ball between the arms, then needle-felt it onto the arms and the body. For the light trim on the coat, spread 1 g of ecru-coloured wool on the felting pad and needle-felt it to form a circle with approx. 5 cm (2 inches) Ø. Needle-felt this light circle onto the base of the



body. Loosely felt the remaining ecru-coloured wool to the head and around the face to form the beard and hair. For the cheeks, mix small amounts of orchid and red wool, lay the cheeks in place, and needle-felt them in place. Now felt the mouth with red wool and the eyes with black wool.
