

Sandal Socks with big toe

Size 34/35 and 36/37 with big toe
 Directions for the smaller size are before the stroke, with larger sizes behind. If there is only one figure, it applies to all sizes.

Material

Regia 4-fädig, 50 g each # 2041 yellow, # 2082 green, # 00540 blue, # 1259 jaffa

Four size 1-3 (2-3 mm) double pointed needles, or size to obtain gauge.

Welt pattern. alt K2, P2

Stockinet stitch (st-st): K RS rows; P WS rows, in rounds K all sts.

Stripes

* 7 rounds yellow, 1 round each green, yellow and blue, 7 round yellow, 1 round each jaffa, yellow and green, 7 rounds yellow, 1 round each blue, yellow and jaffa, rep * from throughout.

Gauge

30 sts. and 42 rows/rounds st-st, each to 4" (10 cm) on size 1-3 needles.

Method, right sock

Cast on 56/60 sts. yellow and work 8 cm welt patt. Cont for 6/8 cm st-st in stripe sequence. Then work sock in st-st foll stripe sequence to start of toes, foll sock guide. Work heel and gusset in jaffa. When foot measures 18/18.5 cm work on sided toe shaping with separate big toe in st-st as given in table.

For right sock slip 16/20 sts. onto a holder, half the sts. from end of needle 3, and half from start of needle 4; for left sock slip these 16/20 sts. onto a holder from end of needle 1 and start of needle 2.

For bar between the large and adjoining toe cast on 4 sts. anew to the rem sts. for one-sided toe shaping.

Then cont over these 44 sts. as foll: for right sock arrange the bar sts. on needles 3 and 4. To dec 1 st. work to 3 from end of needle 1, then K2 tog, K1; on needle 2 K 1st st., then work a slip dec knitwise over sts. 2-3, work rem sts. in patt. Rep these inc on every 2nd



round 3 times and on every round 6 times = 24 sts. Then dec 2 sts. evenly across 4 times as given in chart as foll: work to 4 from end of needle 1, then K3 tog; on needle 2 work K1, slip 2nd st. knitwise, K2 tog, pass slipped st. over = 8 sts. Bring the double yarn through these sts., pull up firmly and fasten off.

For big toe pick up 4 sts. along gusset, then work st-st yellow over 20/24 sts. to 3 round from end. Work last 3 round in jaffa. Cut final ends in jaffa and use to make small loops, then wind up 3 times and cut open. Work left sock alike, but in revers.

Embroider toes as foll: duplicate stitch in green onto 2nd round, starting and ending at upper center, then tie initial and final threads to make a small bow. Embroider a face in blue above this, with the eyes in French knots, the nose is a duplicate stitch, and the mouth stem sts.

Turn welt out and knot in tassels into P rib, in order in jaffa, green and blue as foll: cut threads each about 8 cm lang and arrange in threes. Fold threads in half, bring loop through the garment, then bring loose ends through the loop and pull up. Finally cut tassels back to about 2,5 cm in length
